SCHOOL CODE OF CONDUCT POLICY - LEARNERS

The School fully supports the principles of fair discipline and the consistent application of appropriate disciplinary measures where necessary.

The Code of Conduct for children indicates the broad standards of behaviour that are expected of all children at the school, and encourages a responsible and self-disciplined approach by children themselves.

Should expected norms of conduct not be met by any child, corrective action will be initiated by the School's Management. This may or may not include the application of formal disciplinary measures to restore the teacher / child relationship to prevent further occurrences of the unacceptable behaviour.

The Code of Conduct may also have a bearing on a child's behaviour outside of normal school hours, should the conduct impact negatively on the teacher / child relationship or the reputation and integrity of the School.

Pupils

In terms of the SA Constitution, every child has the right to education. The School strives to provide the educational opportunities that its children and the community deserve. Children must also recognize that they have responsibilities to their parents, the School, their teachers, their fellow learners and themselves.

Children therefore must accept and comply with the school Code of Conduct and Disciplinary Procedure. In more general terms, they must:

- Comply with instructions from School officials and with the general rules of the School.
- Behave responsibly and not endanger the safety, welfare and rights of others.
- Respect and care for the property of the School and others.
- Ensure that he/she attends all school days, relevant functions and activities.
- Maintain sound relations with others at the School, be courteous and respect the dignity and self-worth of others and avoid any kind of bullying.
- Be punctual at all times.

- Demonstrate a positive attitude towards the opportunity to learn and be diligent in his/her efforts to learn.
- Use the internet and Social Media in a responsible manner
- Behave honestly and conduct himself/herself with integrity.
- Accept legitimate disciplinary action taken against him/her as being necessary.

The School has a number of rules that define the kinds of behaviour expected of its children. Pupils are also to keep their parents advised of these rules and pupils are expected to conduct themselves in accordance with the rules provided.
